The school was founded in 1965 by the Session of Briarwood Presbyterian Church beginning with a kindergarten program for four and five year old children. A first grade class was added the next year and in 1968 classes were opened for second through sixth grades. BCS had its first graduating class in 1973. The growth of the school has been steady and blessed.

Today the school has 1,900 students on two beautiful campuses approximately seven miles apart. The North campus, with over 1,100 students in grades K4-6, is located at 2204 Briarwood Way, Birmingham, Alabama 35243 off of Acton Road and I-459. The South campus, with almost 900 students in grades 7-12, is located on 6255 Cahaba Valley Road, Birmingham, Alabama 35242.

Briarwood Christian School is committed to providing a comprehensive Christian college preparatory educational program of uncompromising quality within a stimulating and nurturing environment. From our *Foundations and Frameworks* program, an instructional reading program for elementary school children, to our advanced placement classes in the high school, BCS is providing our students with an education that develops the mind, nurtures the soul, and shapes the character ... for today and for the future.
